CoverCress® Inc. is the proud recipient of multiple 2019 awards and grants. Beyond recognition, these bring additional resources and capabilities enabling us to develop an even better product for Midwestern farmers and the environment. CoverCress is the unique crop that works as a cover crop in the fall and a harvestable crop in early spring. It has low carbon intensity and grows on unused land over winter.

Recent awards and grants:

CoverCress Inc. is among the first cohort of agricultural startup companies to participate in the **Wells Fargo Innovation Incubator (IN**²) program along with 4 others. IN² named CoverCress, Inc. and the **Donald Danforth Plant Science Center** \$250K award recipients to support research activities towards the genetic improvement of pennycress.

CoverCress has also been awarded a **Small Business Innovation Research** (**SBIR**) grant. This grant along with the Danforth Center research capabilities will expand our research on plant health.

Our largest grant goes beyond CoverCress, with an award of \$10M over 5 years by USDA's National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) to 4 universities and CoverCress Inc. for research on pennycress commercialization.
